The Maryland Community Health System (MCHS) supports *Senate Bill 394 - Public Health - Expedited Partner Therapy - Bacterial Vaginosis*. The bill adds bacterial vaginosis to Maryland's expedited partner therapy law. As a network of federally qualified health centers, MCHS has found Maryland's expedited partner therapy program to be an effective clinical tool to prevent reinfection of our patients from chlamydia, gonorrhea, and trichomoniasis. We support the addition of bacterial vaginosis to this list per the recommendation of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecologists.<sup>i</sup> Bacterial vaginosis is the most common vaginal infection of women of child bearing age.<sup>ii</sup>
