As the County Council Vice President for Harford County, I oppose the current redistricting plan as it is a clear effort to weaken the voices of Republican voters in Maryland and, in doing so, fails the people I represent.

By carving up conservative communities, including those here in Harford County, and attaching them to heavily Democratic districts, the plan dilutes Republican voting strength and undermines the principle that every vote should count equally.

Maryland already has one of the most unbalanced congressional maps in the nation, and this proposal makes it worse. It ignores community boundaries, lacks transparency, and puts partisan gain ahead of democratic integrity.

Redistricting should serve the people, not politicians. For the sake of my constituents and voters across our state, I urge my colleagues to reject this map and pursue a fair, bipartisan process that respects political diversity and restores trust in our elections.
