House Joint Resolution 7 – Back From the Brink Resolution SUPPORT

Carrington & Associates, LLC strongly supports House Joint Resolution 7, introduced by Prince George’s County Delegation Chair, the Honorable Nicole A. Williams, who has led this effort for several years. The importance of this measure is reflected in the record number of co-sponsors—44 in total—who have joined in bringing attention to this pressing issue during a time of heightened global concern. House Joint Resolution 7 focuses on the urgent issue of nuclear weapons and seeks to align Maryland with other states, counties, and municipalities that have endorsed the Back from the Brink framework.
