

**HJ 0010:** Condemning Violence and Violations of Law - Russian Federation in Ukraine:  
Please vote to **OPPOSE** this bill.

Dear Rules and Executive Nominations Committee:

I am writing to **strongly oppose House Joint Resolution 0010**.

While the suffering in Ukraine is tragic, this joint resolution is not an appropriate use of the Maryland General Assembly's time or authority.

Maryland's state legislature should focus on the real challenges facing our residents — skyrocketing housing costs, education quality, public safety, transportation, and unsustainable state spending — rather than issuing non-binding foreign policy statements about an overseas conflict. Such resolutions achieve nothing concrete while signaling that Annapolis prioritizes symbolic international posturing over the needs of Maryland families and taxpayers.

My main concerns include:

- **Outside core mission:** The Maryland General Assembly has no role in conducting or influencing U.S. foreign policy. That responsibility belongs to the federal government and Congress.
- **One-sided and escalatory:** The resolution adopts a highly partisan narrative on a complex geopolitical conflict without balanced consideration or acknowledgment of diplomatic realities.
- **Precedent for misuse:** Passing symbolic resolutions on distant wars opens the door to endless similar statements on every international issue, further distracting from state governance.

**Maryland lawmakers should resist the temptation to turn the statehouse into a forum for foreign policy debates. Our elected officials were sent to Annapolis to solve Maryland problems, not to weigh in on conflicts halfway around the world.**

I respectfully urge you to **oppose HJ 0010** and vote against its passage. Please keep the focus on the issues that directly affect Maryland residents.
