Good morning! Members of the Judicial Proceedings Committee, my name is Sean, I live in Laurel, Maryland, and I am writing to support SB 0001, Prohibition on Face Coverings.

Trust in public servants and civic institutions, like our local police and fire departments, is part of what has always made America great. However, that trust is a two-way street - both parties have to keep up their end of the bargain to keep this trust from eroding.
