**SB 0010 - State Highway Administration – Speed Monitoring Systems –
Application Approval**

Chair Smith, Vice Chair Waldstreicher, and members of the Judicial Proceedings Committee,

The City of Greenbelt supports Senate Bill 0010, which establishes a clear and reasonable timeline for the State Highway Administration to act on applications for speed monitoring systems.

By requiring applications to be approved, denied, or returned as incomplete within 90 days of receipt, the bill provides predictability for local jurisdictions seeking to implement traffic safety measures. The deemed approval provision further ensures that applications are not left unresolved indefinitely, allowing municipalities to plan and deploy safety tools in a timely and responsible manner.

Speed monitoring systems are an important component of local traffic safety efforts, particularly in areas experiencing persistent speeding concerns. Clear administrative timelines support coordination with residents, effective planning, and consistent implementation of safety initiatives.

For these reasons, the City of Greenbelt respectfully supports Senate Bill 0010 and urges the Committee to issue a favorable report.
