

As a member of the Route 210 Traffic Safety Committee and a resident of Fort Washington, Maryland, I support Senate Bill 206 Speed Monitoring Systems-Maryland Route 210-Penalties.

As a member of the Route 210 Traffic Safety Committee, I attend monthly meetings. A member of the local police department reports that drivers speed more than 100 miles per hour every month on Route 210.

Senate Bill 206 Speed Monitoring Systems-Maryland Route 210-Penalties would require the Motor Vehicle Administration under certain circumstances to suspend the registration of motor vehicles involved in multiple violations recorded by a speed monitoring system placed on Maryland Route 210.

I travel Route 210 to go from Fort Washington to Waldorf. Upon returning from a recent trip I saw a car smashed up going south near Swann Creek Road. One of these vehicles involved in the accident must have been speeding at a high rate of speed.

Something needs to be done to hold speeders accountable on Route 210.
