

**Testimony on SB0985:** Correctional Services - Immigration Detention Facilities - Minimum Mandatory Standards

**Judicial Proceedings Committee**

Dear Honorable Chair Smith, Vice Chair Waldstreicher, and Members of the Committee,

My name is Christina M. Yuan, MD and I am a resident of Laurel, MD. I strongly urge the committee to pass SB0985.

This bill seeks to codify common-sense guardrails on the operation of detention centers and correctional facilities. Given reports of [human rights abuses](#) and [disease outbreaks](#) at the Fallon Center in Baltimore, where a hundred or more immigrants are crammed into tight spaces with no access to clean water or sanitary facilities, there is a clear need for laws that enforce basic health and safety standards on the operation of these facilities.

The companies that operate these facilities have a lot to gain by cutting corners on health and safety. [CoreCivic](#) and [Geo Group](#) will rake in \$1B in revenue from government contracts this year alone and their leaders consider the expansion of mass deportation in the United States “[one of the most exciting periods](#),” due to the windfalls they stand to receive. Their goal is to create these detention centers as quickly and as cheaply as possible. In the absence of humane and enforceable standards for health and safety, they will have little regard as to whether detainees are treated with decency.

In addition, these corporations care little about protecting the health, safety, and resources of the surrounding community. These detention facilities put pressure on local resources (water, sewage, health care) and may drive up community costs, while treating both detainees and local citizens as “pallets of goods”.

Maryland has an obligation to implement laws that protect the health and safety of all human beings, including those who are detained or incarcerated. For these reasons, I respectfully urge a favorable report on SB0985.
