These agents are consistently acting with excessive force and engaging in acts of intimidation and provocation that directly cause the civil unrest they then use as a pretext for further acts of brutality while hiding their faces and badges from the public.

These civil rights violations undermine the rule of law and undermine public safety. ICE as it is currently constituted is more of an arm of state repression than a law enforcement agency.
