To the Judicial Proceedings Committee,

My name is Keily Pacheco, and I'm a 11th grade student at Baltimore City College and a member of Students Organizing a Multicultural Open Society. I support SB0001, Public Safety - Law Enforcement Officers - Prohibition on Face Coverings.

This bill will protect the public by requiring law enforcement officers to have their faces visible while on duty, except in specific circumstances where face coverings are necessary for safety or health reasons. By prohibiting unnecessary face coverings (facemasks, skimasks, ect), this bill promotes transparency and accountability in policing, making it easier for community members to identify officers and build trust with law enforcement.

I believe that passing this bill is essential because it helps ensure that police officers are recognizable and accountable for their actions.
