My name is Chauna Brocht, and I am a resident of Baltimore City. I am writing in support of **Public Safety - Law Enforcement Officers - Prohibition on Face Coverings**.

I support **SB 1** because allowing law enforcement to cover their faces is an impediment to accountability and creates fear of law enforcement. When people fear contact with law enforcement, they are less likely to report crimes, seek help, or cooperate as witnesses—even when they are victims.
