**Re: Strong Support for Senate Bill 1**

Chair Smith, Vice Chair Waldstreicher, and Members of the Committee:

On behalf of the City of Mount Rainier, I respectfully submit this testimony in **strong support of Senate Bill 1**, legislation that promotes transparency, accountability, and public trust in law enforcement by prohibiting the use of face coverings by law enforcement officers while performing official duties, except when engaged in undercover operations.

For the City, this legislation is especially important given our community's strong emphasis on relationship-based, community-oriented public safety. Mount Rainier is a diverse municipality where residents regularly interact with the same officers at community events, neighborhood patrols, and local meetings. Clear visibility and identification of officers during these interactions is essential to maintaining trust, de-escalating conflict, and ensuring that residents feel safe and respected. When community members can clearly see and identify the officers serving them, it strengthens legitimacy, improves cooperation, and supports the collaborative public safety model Mount Rainier has worked hard to build.

Senate Bill 1 strikes an appropriate and thoughtful balance between **public transparency and officer safety**. By directing the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission to develop a model policy, the bill ensures statewide consistency while allowing for professional standards grounded in best practices. At the same time, the exception for undercover operations appropriately recognizes circumstances where anonymity is necessary to protect officers and preserve the integrity of investigations.

Mount Rainier supports this legislation because it reinforces the principle that public servants, especially those entrusted with significant authority, should operate in a manner that is visible and accountable to the communities they serve. Clear identification not only protects residents, but also protects officers by reducing confusion, miscommunication, and mistrust during interactions.

For these reasons, the City of Mount Rainier urges the Committee to issue a **favorable report on Senate Bill 1** and move this important legislation forward.
