This is a wonderful companion bill to HB155 which unfortunately has not moved in your committee. Just like the public should be able to see the face of any ICE officer or other law enforcement, those public servants should identify themselves.

Ironically, if a person comes to service your washing machine or heater, they have to identify their company and their name. However, a law enforcement officer is not required to identify themselves.

With all of the horrendous behavior going on in our country this year, much of it caught on video tape, the public should be able to identify which agency the individual is working for. This law would develop a consistent policy across all agencies.

For all these reasons, I recommend a favorable report on HB1415.
