

HB 675: Public Safety - Immigration Enforcement - Immigration Enforcement

Dear Judiciary Committee:

I am writing to strongly urge you to **SUPPORT HB 675**.

HB 675 enables correctional facility coordination to identify and transfer individuals subject to federal immigration enforcement, with penalties for non-compliance.

This bill is necessary to **prioritize public safety. Allowing coordination ensures that individuals who pose risks—particularly those with criminal histories—are not released back into communities prematurely.** This targeted, correctional facility model (not broad street enforcement) enhances coordination to remove criminal non-citizens and protects Maryland residents without overburdening local resources.

Maryland should not obstruct immigration enforcement for public safety threats. Requiring these coordination efforts **restores accountability, deters illegal activity, and aligns with common-sense priorities for safer communities**—especially amid ongoing concerns about crime and repeat offenses.

For these reasons, I respectfully ask you to vote **in favor of HB 675**.
