HB0821 – Judicial Removal – Disqualification From Future Judicial Office

I am submitting this testimony in support of HB0821 on behalf of the Maryland Legislative Coalition. We are an association of unpaid citizen advocates—individuals and grassroots groups in every district—representing more than 30,000 Marylanders.

HB0821 proposes a constitutional amendment to ensure that any judge removed from office or retired upon recommendation of the Commission on Judicial Disabilities is permanently disqualified from serving again. If a judge's conduct is serious enough to warrant removal, the public should not have to worry about that person returning to the bench.

It is unfortunate that we even need a bill like this. In a time when shame and empathy seem to be in short supply, clear standards of accountability matter more than ever. Marylanders deserve to know that those entrusted with judicial power are held to the highest ethical expectations.

HB0821 supports the mission of the Maryland Legislative Coalition by strengthening transparency, accountability, and public trust. People are far more willing to engage with their government when they believe the system is fair and that misconduct is taken seriously.

For these reasons, we respectfully urge a **FAVORABLE** report on HB0821.
