

# Testimony For HB0114

Honorable Delegates

Please enter a favorable report for HB0114.

I support requiring any person involved in a motor vehicle accident that results in the death of, or a life threatening injury to, another person to submit to breath and blood testing for impaired driving.

As I understand the issue, there is no requirement for the driver of a fatal accident to take tests for impaired driving as part of an officer's process to gather evidence at the scene. Because of this, tests are given later which by that time may not show that the driver was impaired or not impaired enough to receive a harsher sentence.

This bill would remedy these situations. Please enter a favorable report for HB0114.
