Dear Honorable Chair Bartlett, Vice Chair Davis and Members of the Committee,

My name is Betsy Krieger and I am a **resident of Baltimore City**. I am writing in support of **HB 0444 – Public Safety – Immigration Enforcement Agreements – Prohibition**.

I am horrified by what this Country is becoming and having our local police- who we are supposed to trust to protect us-involved in this inhuman behavior will only make their jobs more difficult.

I support **HB 0444** because immigration enforcement agreements like 287(g) create fear in immigrant communities and undermine public safety for everyone. When people fear contact with law enforcement, they are less likely to report crimes, seek help, or cooperate as witnesses—even when they are victims.

Programs like 287(g) have been associated with racial profiling, discrimination, and wrongful detention. They divert local resources away from protecting communities and instead entangle local agencies in federal deportation efforts that separate families and destabilize neighborhoods.

For these reasons, I respectfully urge the committee to issue a **favorable report** on **HB 0444**.
