The Maryland Joint Veterans Committee (JVC) **SUPPORTS** HB0857 Income Tax – Subtraction Modification for Military Retirement Income- Individuals Under the Age of 55 for the following reasons:

- Veterans are leaving the state of Maryland for other states with a more favorable tax structure allowing their income or savings to stretch further and cover the veteran’s needs
- Increasing the subtraction for those under the age of 55 from \$12,5000 to \$20,000 is another step towards keeping our veterans in Maryland
 - Currently, 37 states do not tax Military Retired Pay, ([Military.com State Tax Information for Military Members and Retirees](#))
- Lowering taxes increases tax government revenue
