An Act to amend Wicomico Code, Chapter 138 (“Electrical Standards”), Section 18 (“Expiration and renewal of certificates”) to clarify the types of continuing education hours that the Board of Electrical Examiners must accept when reviewing applications to renew certificates of registration.

WHEREAS, the County Code requires that certificates of registration for electricians must be renewed every two years and that applicants must show that they have received a certain amount of continuing education; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Council wants to amend § 138-19 to clarify the types of continuing education hours that the Board of Electrical Examiners must accept when reviewing applications to renew certificates of registration.

Section 1: Be it enacted by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, that Wicomico County Code § 138-18.B is amended to read:

Section 138-18.B Expiration and renewal of certificates.

B. All applicants for renewal shall demonstrate they have received 10 continuing education ~~credits~~ HOURS during each biannual period before renewal of certificate registration may be granted. THE BOARD MUST ACCEPT CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS OBTAINED FROM A LICENSED COLLEGE, TRADE SCHOOL, OR OTHER STATE-RECOGNIZED TRAINING PROGRAM, BUT 5 OF THE 10 HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION MUST BE OBTAINED IN A CLASSROOM SETTING.

Section 2. Be it further enacted that this Bill will be known as Bill No. 2019-02 of Wicomico County, Maryland and will take effect 60 days


after its final passage, unless a timely Petition for Referendum is filed; if that occurs, the Bill will not take effect until the expiration of 30 days following the approval of this Bill by a majority of the qualified voters of the County voting in a referendum.







Introduced and read first time on April 16, 2019. Ordered posted and public hearing scheduled for May 7, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.








BY THE COUNCIL:
