AMENDED LEGISLATIVE BILL 2019 - 07

AN ACT TO IMPOSE AND DECLARE A MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS FOR AN AGRICULTURAL STORAGE TANK WHICH WILL STORE DISSOLVED AIR FLOTATION (DAF) WASHDOWN WATER FROM A RENDERING PROCESS PURSUANT TO WICOMICO COUNTY CODE CHAPTERS 225, 125 AND 128.

WHEREAS, Wicomico County Code Chapter 225 provides for the construction of storage tanks in the A-1 Rural Zone and Chapter 125 and 128 describe the process for issuance of a building permit; and

WHEREAS, residents of Wicomico County have expressed concerns about the building permit process for storage tanks which would store DAF washdown water from a rendering process in the A-1 Rural Zone;

WHEREAS, the Council considers the issuance of a building permit for an agricultural storage tank to store DAF washdown water from a rendering process to be an issue which needs further study and legislative action; and

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its police power as a Charter County, Wicomico County, Maryland, through its elected officials, hereby finds that a moratorium bill is needed and deems that a minimum period of \underline{six} (6) months is necessary for an adequate study of the subject, and for this reason will impose a moratorium on the issuance of Building Permits for an agricultural storage tank to store DAF washdown water from a rendering process for a period of \underline{six} (6) months.

SECTION I: BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WICOMICO COUNTY, MARYLAND, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION, as follows:

- A. A Moratorium is hereby imposed and declared on the issuance of building permits for an agricultural storage tank to store DAF washdown water from a rendering process.
- B. The Moratorium shall apply prospectively only, beginning on the date this bill is enacted and ending on May 5, 2020.

SECTION II: BE IT ENACTED that this Legislative Bill shall be known 2019 - 07 of Wicomico County, Maryland, and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its final passage, unless a proper Petition for Referendum thereof shall be filed prior to said date; in which event, the Bill shall not take effect until the expiration of thirty (30) days following the approval of this Bill by a majority of the qualified voters of the County voting in any such referendum.
