2 on Joining Employee Organizations – Deputy Sheriff III

4 FOR the purpose of allowing Deputy Sheriff III's to join, assist, and participate in certain
5 employee organizations; and generally relating to rights of employees in the classified
6 service.

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
12 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

18 **6-4-105. Rights of classified employees – In general.**

20 **(b) Limitations on joining employee organizations.**

22 (1) With the exception of captains, lieutenants and battalion chiefs in the Fire
23 Department, [and] lieutenants in the Police Department, AND DEPUTY SHERIFF IIIS IN THE
24 SHERIFF'S OFFICE, management employees may not join, assist, or participate in the
25 activities of an employee organization, or an affiliate of an employee organization, that



1 represents or seeks to represent employees under the direction of the management
2 employees. This subsection (b)(1) shall be construed to prohibit Detention Sergeants from
3 joining, assisting, or participating in the activities of an employee organization that
4 represents or seeks to represent Detention Officers and Detention Corporals.




