3	FOR the purpose of prohibiting the application of Bill No. 68-19 to all applications
4	associated with an application for a special exception submitted prior to a certain date;
5	and generally relating to subdivision and development.

7	BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 17-2-101(b)(14)

10	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
11	That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:
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13	ARTICLE 17. SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT
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15	TITLE 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS
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17	17-2-101. Scope; applicability.
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19	(b) Applicability to pending and future proceedings. Subject to the grandfathering
20	provisions of COMAR Title 27, this article applies to all pending and future proceedings
21	and actions of any board, department, or agency empowered to decide applications under
22	this Code, except that:

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1 (14) the following shall be governed by the law as it existed prior to January 9, 2 2020:

4 (i) an application for approval of a sketch plan, final plan, final infrastructure
5 construction plan, preliminary plan, or site development plan, and any building or grading
6 permits associated with these plans, filed on or before December 15, 2019;

8 (ii) applications for building and grading permits that are not associated with a 9 final plan or site development plan filed on or before December 15, 2019;

(iii) revisions to the plans and permits referenced in subparagraphs (i) and (ii)
 that do not materially alter the proposed or actual limits of disturbance; and

(iv) an application for a special exception filed on or before December 15, 2019
 AND ALL APPLICATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SPECIAL EXCEPTION.

SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
 from the date it becomes law.
