3-11-107. Duties of Central Services Officer.

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(A) **Duties.** The Central Services Officer shall:

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(3) review and approve all claims for payment from the Fund for general liability and settlements of workers' compensation claims where the amount to be paid is [[\$10,000]] \$25,000 or less;

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SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
