AN ACT concerning

Voluntary Private Security or Surveillance Camera Registration Program

FOR the purpose of creating a Voluntary Private Security or Surveillance Camera Registration Program; providing for certain incentives for registration; providing for registration requirements; providing for certain restrictions for obtaining and using the Program; <u>authorizing the adoption of certain regulations;</u> providing for the application of the Act; and generally relating to a Voluntary Private Security or Surveillance Camera Registration Program.

16	PROPERTY ARE ENCOURAGED TO UTILIZE AT LEAST ONE SUCH CAMERA
17	POINTED TOWARD A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND TO REGISTER THE LOCATION
18	OF THAT CAMERA <u>THEIR CAMERAS</u> WITH THE COUNTY.
19	(B) A COMMERCIAL OR RESIDENTIAL PRIVATE PROPERTY OWNER MAY
20	REGISTER THEIR PRIVATE SECURITY OR SURVEILLANCE CAMERA ON A WRITTEN
21	FORM PROVIDED BY THE OFFICE OF BUDGET AND FINANCE OR THROUGH AN

23	(C) PRIVATE PROPERTY OWNERS THAT VOLUNTARILY REGISTER A

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PRIVATE SECURITY OR SURVEILLANCE CAMERA WILL RECEIVE THE FOLLOWING
INCENTIVES FOR DOING SO:

(1) THE COUNTY WILL WAIVE THE ALARM PERMIT FEE FOR THE 3 INSTALLATION OF A NEW ALARM SYSTEM THAT INCLUDES PRIVATE SECURITY 4 OR SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS OR THE UPGRADE OF A CURRENT ALARM SYSTEM 5 THAT INCLUDES SUCH CAMERAS: AND 6 (2) PARTICIPANTS IN THE PROGRAM WILL BE PERMITTED TWO ONE 7 ADDITIONAL FALSE ALARM WAIVERS WAIVER IN A CALENDAR YEAR. 8 9 (D) TO PROTECT THE PRIVACY OF SURROUNDING PRIVATE PROPERTY OWNERS, REGISTRATION SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE PROPERTY OWNER CERTIFY 10 THAT THE CAMERA IS LOCATED WHOLLY ON THEIR PROPERTY. AND SHALL AT 11 NO TIME WHILE REGISTERED BE POSITIONED SO AS TO MONITOR PRIVATE 12 PROPERTY OTHER THAN THE PROPERTY ON WHICH IT IS LOCATED. 13 14 § 13-11-303. 15 (1) REGISTRATION RECORDS SHALL BE KEPT BY THE OFFICE OF (A) 16 17 BUDGET AND FINANCE AND SHALL BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. 18 (2) (B) UPON OBTAINING ANY FOOTAGE OR DATA UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, 19 20 SUCH FOOTAGE OR DATA SHALL BE TREATED AS IF IT HAD BEEN OBTAINED FROM A CAMERA OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE COUNTY UTILIZED TO 21 22 FURTHER A LAW ENFORCEMENT INVESTIGATION AND SHALL BE KEPT

23 CONFIDENTIAL TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

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1	(B) REGISTRATION RECORDS AND ANY CAMERA FOOTAGE OR DATA
2	VOLUNTARILY REQUESTED AND OBTAINED THEREFROM SHALL BE UTILIZED
3	ONLY TO FURTHER A LEGITIMATE LAW ENFORCEMENT INVESTIGATION.
4	(C) THE COUNTY SHALL NOT SOLICIT OR USE FOOTAGE OR DATA FROM
5	PRIVATE SECURITY OR SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS WITH SUCH REGULARITY OR
6	IN SUCH A WAY AS TO EFFECTIVELY VIOLATE ANY PERSON'S PRIVACY OR TO
7	EFFECTIVELY CIRCUMVENT STATE OR FEDERAL PRIVACY LAWS OR
8	REGULATIONS.

11	TO PROMOTE AND ENSURE THE CONTINUED ACCURACY OF THE CAMERA
12	LOCATION, REGISTRATION SHALL AUTOMATICALLY EXPIRE AFTER TWO YEARS,
13	AFTER WHICH THE PROPERTY OWNER MAY RENEW THE REGISTRATION IN THE
14	SAME MANNER AS SET FORTH IN § 13-11-302.

17	THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF BUDGET AND FINANCE, IN
18	CONSULTATION WITH THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION
