AN ACT concerning

Parking

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the parking of vehicles in a certain area of the Horses and Hounds

Scenic Byway in certain areas of the Big Gunpowder Falls; providing penalties; and

generally relating to the stopping, standing, and parking of vehicles.

BY adding

Section 18-2-213 Article 18 – Transportation Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic Subtitle 2 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking – In General Baltimore County Code 2015

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

(A) PARKING PROHIBITED. A PERSON MAY NOT PARK A VEHICLE ON THE 3 4 ROADWAY, SHOULDER AREA, OR ANY GRASSY AREA ABUTTING THE ROAD ALONG THE HORSES AND HOUNDS SCENIC BYWAY ON MONKTON ROAD BETWEEN 5 6 THE AREAS OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH OLD MONKTON ROAD AND SHEPPARD 7 ROAD. IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS ALONG THE BIG GUNPOWDER FALLS: 8 (1) ON MONKTON ROAD BETWEEN THE AREAS OF ITS INTERSECTION 9 WITH BLUE MOUNT ROAD AND SHEPPERD ROAD; 10 (2) ON BLUE MOUNT ROAD BETWEEN THE AREAS OF ITS 11 INTERSECTION WITH MONKTON ROAD AND THE TORREY C. BROWN RAIL TRAIL. 12 (3) ON FALLS ROAD BETWEEN THE AREAS OF ITS INTERSECTION 13 WITH MONKTON ROAD AND CORBETT ROAD; 14 (4) ON CORBETT ROAD BETWEEN THE AREAS OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH FALLS ROAD AND MATTHEWS ROAD; 15 16 ON OLD MONKTON ROAD BETWEEN THE AREAS OF ITS (5) 17 INTERSECTION WITH MONKTON ROAD AND MATTHEWS ROAD; AND (6) ON NOTCHCLIFF ROAD BETWEEN THE AREAS OF ITS 18 19 INTERSECTION WITH GLEN ARM ROAD AND HARFORD ROAD. 20 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OWNED OR OPERATED BY, OR PURSUANT TO THE DIRECTION OF, A PUBLIC SERVICE 21 22 COMPANY AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN § 1-101(x) OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES 23 ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND IF PARKING OR STANDING

1	THE COMMERCIAL VEHICLE IS ESSENTIAL TO THE OFFICIAL USE THEN BEING
2	MADE OF THE COMMERCIAL VEHICLE.
3	(B) (C) A VEHICLE PARKED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS PUNISHABLE
4	BY A FINE OF \$150 <u>\$200</u> .

6	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the Baltimore County
7	Department of Public Works shall ensure that language on the "no parking" signs along the area
8	of Monkton Road affected by this Act that in the areas along the Big Gunpowder Falls affected by
9	<u>this Act</u> states " \$150 <u>\$200</u> fine."
10	
11	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the Publisher is instructed that
12	this Act shall replace and supersede § 18-2-213 of the Baltimore County Code, which was
13	established in Bill 67-17 and took effect on December 4, 2017, but which was permitted to expire
14	two (2) years after the date of its enactment without further action by the County Council.

16	SECTION 34 . AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
17	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on August 17, 2020.
