ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Restrictions on Parking in Greater Towson

FOR the purpose of limiting parking of vehicles in certain areas and under certain circumstances
in the Greater Towson Area; and generally relating to parking.

BY adding

Section 18-2-215
Article 18 – Transportation
Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic
Subtitle 2 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking – In General
Baltimore County Code, 2015

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

ARTICLE 18 – TRANSPORTATION

Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic

§ 18-2-215. RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING IN GREATER TOWSON.

(A) IN THE AREA OF GREATER TOWSON ENCOMPASSED WITHIN THE TOWSON PRECINCT (PRECINCT 6) OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT, A VEHICLE PARKED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY MAY ONLY BE SITUATED ON A CONCRETE, ASPHALT PAVED, OR DURABLE AND DUSTLESS SURFACE THAT IS INTENDED FOR THE PARKING OF VEHICLES EXCEPT FOR A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE OTHERWISE LEGALLY PARKED AND ONLY FOR THE PERIOD OF TIME ESSENTIAL FOR THE IMMEDIATE USE OF THE VEHICLE.

(B) A VEHICLE PARKED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF \$75.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on October 19, 2020.
