A BILL
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Parking Along the Big Gunpowder Falls

FOR the purpose of specifying the penalty for the parking of vehicles in certain posted “no parking” areas of the Big Gunpowder Falls; and generally relating to the stopping, standing, and parking of vehicles.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 18-2-213

Article 18 – Transportation

Title 2 – Vehicles and Traffic

Subtitle 2 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking – In General

Baltimore County Code 2015

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

1 §18-2-213. Parking along the Big Gunpowder Falls.

1 (a) A person may not park a vehicle on the roadway, shoulder area, or any grassy area
2 abutting the road WHERE THERE ARE POSTED “NO PARKING” SIGNS in the following areas
3 along the Big Gunpowder Falls:

4 (1) On Monkton Road between the areas of its intersection with Blue Mount Road
5 and [Shepperd] MANOR BROOK Road;

6 (2) On Blue Mount Road between the areas of its intersection with Monkton Road
7 and the Torrey C. Brown Rail Trail;

8 (3) On Falls Road between the areas of its intersection with Monkton Road and
9 Corbett Road;

10 (4) On Corbett Road between the areas of its intersection with Falls Road and
11 Matthews Road;

12 (5) On Old Monkton Road WEST between the areas of its intersection with
13 Monkton Road and Matthews Road; and

14 (6) On Notchcliff Road between the areas of its intersection with Glen Arm Road
15 and Harford Road.

16 (b) This section does not apply to commercial vehicles owned or operated by, or pursuant
17 to the direction of, a public service company as that term is defined in § 1-101(x) of the Public
18 Utilities Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland if parking or standing the commercial vehicle
19 is essential to the official use then being made of the commercial vehicle.

20 (c) A vehicle parked in violation of this section is punishable by a fine of \$200.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the Baltimore County Department
23 of Public Works shall ensure that language on the “no parking” signs situated in the areas along

1 the Big Gunpowder Falls affected by this Act states “\$200 fine.”

3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the

4 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on October 19, 2020.
