AN ACT concerning

Parking of Commercial Vehicles

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the parking of certain commercial vehicles in the MD 43 Overlay District; providing certain parking restrictions on certain vehicles at specific times; and generally relating to vehicle parking.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

5 TITLE 2 - VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

6 Subtitle 2. - Stopping, Standing, and Parking - In General

8 § 18-2-206. Parking a commercial vehicle in a residential zone.

9 (a) This section applies to residential zones as provided in the county zoning regulations.

10 (b) This section does not apply to the following vehicles even if they are used for
11 commercial purposes:

12 (1) Private passenger type vehicles, including automobiles, minivans, passenger
13 vans, station wagons, and sport utility vehicles;

14 (2) Pickup trucks; and

15 (3) Panel-body delivery trucks having not more than three-quarters of a ton

2 (c) A person may not park or stand a commercial vehicle on any public road, street, or
3 way within a residential zone in the county, unless parking or standing the commercial vehicle is
4 essential to the immediate use then being made of the commercial vehicle.

5 (d) PROHIBITION IN THE MD 43 OVERLAY DISTRICT. A PERSON MAY NOT
6 PARK OR STAND A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE ON ANY PUBLIC ROAD, STREET,
7 ALLEY OR WAY NORTH OF TANGIER DRIVE AND WEST OF EARLS ROAD IN THE
8 MD 43 OVERLAY DISTRICT. THIS PROHIBITION SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY
9 PRIVATE ROAD WITHIN THE MD 43 OVERLAY DISTRICT.

10 [(d)] (E) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.

11 [(e)] (F) If the commercial vehicle parked in violation of this section consists of a tractor,
12 trailer, or a combination tractor-trailer, the person violating this section is subject to a fine of
13 \$250 each for the tractor or trailer and \$500 for a tractor and trailer, in combination, for each day
14 the violation exists.

16 § 18-2-215. - PARKING LARGE TRUCKS AT NIGHT.

17 (A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, NO TRACTOR, TRAILER, OR
18 COMBINATION TRACTOR-TRAILER MAY PARK OR STAND LONGER THAN ONE
19 HOUR CONTINUOUSLY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 1:00 A.M. AND 7:00 A.M. ON ANY
20 PUBLIC ROAD, STREET, ALLEY OR WAY THAT IS WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF A
21 RESIDENTIAL ZONE IN THE COUNTY.

22 (B) THE SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:

23 (1) SERVICE VEHICLES OWNED OR OPERATED BY THE COUNTY OR A

1 PUBLIC UTILITY; OR

2 (2) EMERGENCY VEHICLES OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY POLICE OR
3 FIRE DEPARTMENTS OR A VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICE.

4 (C) (1) A VEHICLE PARKED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT
5 TO A FINE OF \$250.

6 (2) EACH DAY A VIOLATION EXISTS SHALL CONSTITUTE A
7 SEPARATE VIOLATION.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
10 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on November 2,
11 2020.
