AN ACT to amend Article V, *District Regulations*, Section 10, *Crossroads Commercial District*, Section 10.2 *Permitted Principal Uses and Structures*, by adding a new §21 in order to allow a "Microbrewery as defined by the State of Maryland" as a permitted use by right in the Crossroads Commercial District, and by adding a new §22 in order to allow a "Class D Alcohol Retail Business as defined by the State of Maryland" as a permitted use by right in the Crossroads Commercial District.

**MICROBREWERIES AND CLASS D ALCOHOL RETAIL BUSINESSES
IN THE CROSSROADS COMMERCIAL DISTRICT**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF KENT COUNTY, MARYLAND that the Kent County Land Use Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE V.

DISTRICT REGULATIONS

SECTION 10. CROSSROADS COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

...

10.2 PERMITTED PRINCIPAL USES AND STRUCTURES

A building or land may be used only for the following purposes, in all cases subject to site plan review by the Planning Commission, or where applicable the Planning Director.

1. *Agriculture*, excluding the raising of livestock and fowl, including horticulture, hydroponics, and truck farming, general farming, cultivation of field crops, and raising of orchards, groves, and nurseries.

19. Veterinary hospitals and offices

20. Wayside stands - vegetable and agricultural produce

21. MICROBREWERY, AS DEFINED BY THE STATE OF MARYLAND

22. CLASS D ALCOHOL RETAIL BUSINESS, AS DEFINED BY THE STATE OF MARYLAND


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the County Commissioners of Kent County that this Act shall take effect on the 28 day of August, 2020.
