BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Personnel Board

3 For the purpose of amending the compensation rates for the Prince George’s County Personnel
4 Board.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

7 Section 16-104,

8 The Prince George's County Code

9 (2015 Edition; 2019 Supplement).

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 16-104 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
12 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 **SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.**

14 **DIVISION 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.**

15 **Sec. 16-104. County Personnel Board; composition; appointment; terms; removal;**
16 **compensation.**

17 * * * * *

18 (b) The members of the Personnel Board shall be compensated at the rate of [Four Hundred
19 Dollars (\$400.00)] Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per month. The Chair thereof shall be
20 compensated an additional [One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)] Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
21 per month for administrative responsibilities.

1 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
2 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
3 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
4 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
5 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
6 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
7 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
8 or section.

9 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
10 calendar days after it becomes law.
