A BILL TO ESTABLISH THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE SHERIFF FOR TALBOT COUNTY TO BECOME EFFECTIVE FOR TERMS BEGINNING IN AND AFTER 2022

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Chapter 155 of the Talbot County Code, entitled “Sheriff”, shall be and is hereby amended as set forth herein.

Chapter 155, SHERIFF

* * *

§ 155-5. Salary

The salary of the Sheriff of Talbot County shall be established at the beginning of each term at the starting rate of 88,500 ~~\$115,000 annually~~, to include any cumulative cost-of-living and/or step salary increases that the governing body of Talbot County may grant to County employees. Upon re-election of an incumbent, their ~~then-existing~~ salary shall not re-base to the starting rate. Once established, the salary of the Sheriff shall not be increased, except for cumulative cost-of-living and/or step salary adjustments, or decreased, during the remainder of the four-year term of office.

§ 155-6. When effective

In accordance with Article III, Section 35, of the Maryland Constitution, any increase or decrease in compensation is to become effective for the Sheriff’s term beginning in or after the year 2014 2022.

SECTION 2: BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that, in accordance with Article III, Section 35 of the Maryland Constitution, any increase or decrease in compensation is to become effective for terms beginning in and after the year 2022.
