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- A. [The minimum area of the lot shall be ½ acre] THE LOT ON WHICH THE USE IS LOCATED MUST BE A MINIMUM OF ONE -HALF (½) ACRE IN SIZE.
- B. [It] THE USE must be housed in a fully enclosed, sound proof building.
- C. Except in the HVC, HVG, WC and AUC Zones, [it] **THE USE** shall be located a minimum of 75 feet from any road or street and no less than 125 feet from the nearest dwelling. In the HVC and HVG Zones, the use shall be located at least 125 feet from the nearest dwelling and shall comply with the applicable setback requirements for the HVC and HVG Zones, codified in §297-99of this chapter.
- D. [It] THE USE must conform to standards of the County Animal Regulations and applicable state and local laws.

**SECTION 2.** BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
