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### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Supplementary Appropriations

2  
3 FOR the purpose of making supplementary appropriations from unanticipated revenues to  
4 certain offices, departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies in the  
5 general fund and to certain special funds of the County government for the current  
6 fiscal year; and generally relating to making supplementary appropriations of funds to  
7 the current expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

9 BY amending: Current Expense Budget

10  
11 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the  
12 County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations  
13 from revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates  
14 and from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the  
15 current fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such  
16 funds are available for appropriation; and

18 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer and  
19 supplementary appropriation of certain funds, and the Controller has certified in  
20 writing that such funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore,

22 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
23 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, be and it is  
24 hereby amended by making supplementary appropriations from revenues received from  
25 sources not anticipated in the budget and revenues received from anticipated sources but  
26 in excess of budget estimates in the total amount of \$1,242,808 to the Grants Special  
27 Revenue Fund, as follows:


