A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Licenses and Registrations – Amusements
2 – Licensing of Coin-Operated Amusement Devices

4 FOR the purpose of allowing a Class E license for coin-operated amusement devices to be
5 issued to a Class I licensee; making this Ordinance an emergency measure; and
6 generally relating to licenses and registrations.

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
12 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

14 ARTICLE 11. LICENSES AND REGISTRATIONS

15 TITLE 2. AMUSEMENTS

16 11-2-502. Licenses classified. 17

18 (b) **Class E.** A Class E license is required for a single location or single room of a
19 building in which are located less than twenty coin-operated amusement devices. A Class
20 E license may be issued only to the owner or operator of the location or room of a building
21 in which coin-operated amusement devices are located OR TO A CLASS I LICENSEE.

25 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
26 emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,


