5 applications for BRAC Mixed Use Development established by Bill No. 31-22; and
6 generally relating to subdivision and development.

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
12 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

13 14 ARTICLE 17. SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT

15 16 TITLE 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

17 18 17-2-101. Scope; applicability.

20 (b) **Applicability to pending and future proceedings.** Subject to the grandfathering
21 provisions of COMAR Title 27, this article applies to all pending and future proceedings
22 and actions of any board, department, or agency empowered to decide applications under
23 this Code, except that:

25 (15) an application for sketch plan approval, final plan approval, preliminary plan
26 approval, or approval of a building or grading permit associated with a BRAC Mixed Use

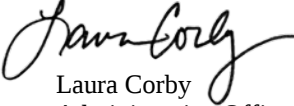
