AN ACT concerning

County Code – Pensions and Retirement – Salary Scale and Other Adjustments – Reporting

FOR the purpose of requiring certain notice be given to the County Council relating to certain salary scale and other salary changes, and certain impacts to Retirement System funding; and generally relating to the Employees' Retirement System.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

ARTICLE 5 – PENSIONS AND RETIREMENT

Title 1 – Employees’ Retirement System

Subtitle 1 – In General

§ 5-1-105.

FOR ANY COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT OR OTHER EMPLOYEE SALARY  
SCALE ADJUSTMENTS PROPOSED IN THE ANNUAL EXPENSE BUDGET OR FOR  
ANY PERSONNEL OR RETIREMENT-RELATED LEGISLATION SUBMITTED TO THE  
COUNTY COUNCIL, THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF BUDGET AND FINANCE  
SHALL ATTACH A STATEMENT TO THE BUDGET BILL OR OTHER LEGISLATION ON  
THE DATE THE BILL IS INTRODUCED THAT CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING:

(1) THE FULL ANNUALIZED SALARY COST OF THE ADJUSTMENT, BY FUND  
AND ~~PROGRAM~~ DEPARTMENT;

(2) ANY SECONDARY OR OTHER COSTS, BY FUND AND ~~PROGRAM~~  
DEPARTMENT, FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR OVER THE FULL ACTUARIAL  
AMORTIZATION PERIOD FOR EACH ASSOCIATED ACTUARIAL ACCRUED

1 LIABILITY, INCLUDING THE RESULTING ESTIMATED INCREASE TO THE  
2 ACTUARIALLY DETERMINED EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION TO THE EMPLOYEES'  
3 RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND

4 (3) THE TOTAL IMPACT ON THE ACTUARIAL ACCRUED LIABILITY OF THE  
5 EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, BY EMPLOYEE GROUP, AS DETERMINED BY  
6 THE COUNTY'S ACTUARY.

8 § 5-1-246.

9 On the basis of such tables and such actuarial cost method as the Board of Trustees shall  
10 adopt, the actuary shall make an annual valuation of the assets and liabilities of the funds of the  
11 Retirement System. SUCH VALUATION SHALL INCLUDE A SCHEDULE OF ANNUAL  
12 EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS THROUGH THE END OF THE ADOPTED  
13 AMORTIZATION PERIOD AND SHALL IDENTIFY THE SPECIFIC EFFECTS OF ANY  
14 CHANGES IN EXPERIENCE OR ACTUARIAL METHODS OR ASSUMPTIONS ON THE  
15 PRIOR YEAR'S SCHEDULE.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by  
18 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect April 18, 2022.
