Zoning Regulations – Distillery Use in the Manufacturing, Light (M.L.) Zone

FOR the purpose of defining the term "distillery" in the Zoning Regulations; permitting certain distillery uses by right in the Manufacturing, Light (M.L.) Zone, subject to certain conditions; and generally relating to uses in the M.L. Zone.
