FOR the purpose of permitting certain woodworking businesses devoted to the sale, storage, and demonstration of certain woodworking tools and products by right in certain areas of the Manufacturing, Light (M.L.) Zone, subject to certain conditions; and generally relating to uses in the M.L. Zone.
