FOR the purpose of amending the 2022-2023 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the

Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from state funds and made

available to the County through the State of Maryland Office of the Governor Opioid

Operational Command Center.

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland Office of the Governor Opioid Operational Command

Center has made an award of state funds available to the Baltimore County Department of

Corrections, to be used to support correctional facilities with the implementation of MAT

programs; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2015, as amended, the County Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund and expend the same, said fund having been established solely for the purpose of accounting for certain monetary gifts and grants made available to the County for restricted purposes; and

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore
