FOR the purpose of defining an "On-Farm Composting Facility"; permitting an on-farm composting facility below a certain size in certain rural conservation zones under certain circumstances; and generally relating to on-farm composting and uses permitted in rural conservation zones.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

11	ON THE FARM WHERE THE COMPOSTING FACILITY IS LOCATED.
12	2. THE PARKING OR STORING OF A SHIPPING FREIGHT
13	CONTAINER, TRACTOR TRAILER, OR TRUCK TRAILER ON A FARM FOR THE SOLE
14	PURPOSE OF HOUSING A COMPOST PILE OR STORING COMPOST DOES NOT
15	CONSTITUTE A TRUCKING FACILITY, TRUCK STOP, OR A GARAGE.

17	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
18	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on November 21,
19	2022.
