The 2022-2023 Current Expense Budget Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund Workforce Solutions to Address Homelessness

FOR the purpose of amending the 2022-2023 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from federal funds and made

available to the County through the State of Maryland Department of Labor.

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland Department of Labor has made an award of federal

funds available to the Baltimore County Department of Economic and Workforce Development,

to be used to assist individuals experiencing, or in danger of experiencing, homelessness to

obtain job skills and find employment; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County

Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2015, as amended, the County

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

5	2023, be and is hereby amended by appropriating federal funds made available to the Baltimore					
6	County Department of Economic and Workforce Development, in the amount herein specified,					
7	to the following program:

9	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by					

10 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect January 1, 2023.
