6	G. In the event that a qualified volunteer dies prior to receiving any benefits under this section				
7	the surviving spouse is entitled to benefits equal to 75% of the benefits earned by the				
8	deceased volunteer. This rate applies to any person who is receiving benefits on or before				
9	July 1, 1989, as well as to any person who begins to receive benefits after July 1, 1989.				
10	These benefits shallterminate upon death or remarriage. THE DECEASED VOLUNTEER				
11	MUST HAVE BEEN: [A "qualified volunteer" is defined as:]

13	(1) One who IS AT LEAST 55 YEARS OF AGE AND has completed				
14	25 years of certified service; or
