BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES 25 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Charles County, Maryland read as follows: 26 27 § 27-1 Number of Commissioners designated; terms; Redistricting Board. (A) There shall be five County Commissioners for Charles County IN ACCORDANCE WITH 28 §27-1(A)(1) THROUGH §27-1(A)(5) OF THIS CHAPTER, WHO ARE REGISTERED VOTER\$ 29 OF THE COUNTY [, four of whom shall be elected at large, with one residing in each of the four County Commissioner Districts of the County. The fifth shall hold the position of President of the 30 31 County Commissioners may reside in any area of the County and shall be elected at large]. The County Commissioners shall be elected at the General Election held in 1994 and every four years 32 33 thereafter, for terms of four years.
