- ordered closed is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of \$1,000.00 or imprisonment for not more than 180 days, or both.
- (c) Each day a violation of Subsection (b) continues is a separate offense.
- (d) In addition to any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement procedure, this Division may be enforced by issuance of a civil citation pursuant to Subtitle 28, Division3 of the County Code.
- (e) The civil monetary fine for each civil violation of this Division shall be [Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)] One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for a first violation and One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for a second and any subsequent violation.
- (f) The Police Department shall be authorized to issue a criminal citation in lieu of the issuance of a civil citation pursuant to Subtitle 28, Division 3 of this Code.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
