Title 6 – Exempt Service Employees

§ 4-6-101.

(a) Beginning the first full pay period on or after July 1, 2023, the following officers and employees in the exempt service of the County, and those hired after July 1, 2023, are entitled to compensation at the pay ranges indicated in the following chart, until changed by County legislation. Unless a given pay range is indicated as "hourly[,]" OR "DAILY" the range refers to annual compensation.

CHAIR, PLANNING BOARD	\$20,000	\$20,000
MEMBER, POLICE ACCOUNTABILITY BOARD	\$4,000	\$7,500
CHAIR, POLICE ACCOUNTABILITY BOARD	\$7,500	\$7,500
MEMBER, TRIAL BOARD	\$50/DAY	\$50/DAY

1	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
2	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect July 3, 2023.
