plan of any type filed and accepted by April	1, 2024, an applicant may proceed to the next steps
in the approval process and may be reviewed	d, approved and constructed under the prior Zoning
Ordinance and Subdivision Ordinance. All o	f such projects shall indefinitely be entitled to utilize
the provisions of the prior Ordinance for any	y purpose including, but not limited to, site
modifications, expansions or reconstruction,	, changes in use, occupancy or ownership. This shall
also include the right to utilize the processes	and procedures for development approvals (not to
include a rezoning) and the use tables of the	prior Ordinance. The rights under this Section shall
not be affected by changes in ownership or t	tenancy. The right to utilize the provisions of the
prior Ordinance established by this section s	shall not be limited or affected by Sections 27-1703,
27-1704, and 27-1900 of this Ordinance.]	
SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENAC	CTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five
(45) calendar days after its adoption.
