2	(2) An application for a final plat for subdivision when specifically required in this						
3	Section; and						
4	(3) A conversion of use from residential to nonresidential, or nonresidential to						
5	residential, or the conversion of either a residential or nonresidential use to mixed-use.						
6	(b) Applicability of Public Facility Adequacy Standards						
7	(1) This Section establishes public facility adequacy standards. They are summarized						
8	in Table 24-4502: Summary of Public Facility Adequacy Standards. The standards are						
9	established in Sections 24-4504, Public Facility Adequacy-Generally, through Section 24-4510,						
10	Schools Adequacy, below.

12	(2) An application listed in Section 24-4502(a) above shall not be approved until a						
13	certificate of adequacy or conditional certificate of adequacy is approved in accordance with the						
14	procedures and standards of this Section. No certificate of adequacy or conditional certificate of						
15	adequacy shall be approved unless and until it is reviewed and approved in conjunction with one						
16	of the applications or subdivision reviews identified in Section 24-4502(a) above and Section 24						
17	4503(a).						
18	[(3) The governing body of the County may, by Resolution, waive any public safety						
19	facilities mitigation requirement imposed pursuant to Sections 24-4508 and 24-4509.]						
20	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect thirty (30)						
21	calendar days after it becomes law.
