> STANDARDS for the purpose of prohibiting certain employers from conducting a criminal background check or otherwise inquiring into an applicant's criminal record until the conclusion of a first interview; requiring certain employers to provide prior notice to an applicant when rescinding an offer of employment providing for enforcement by the Executive Director of the Office of Human

Rights; and generally regulating the use of criminal records in the hiring process by

certain employers.

AFFECTED CODE SECTIONS:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

It has been discovered that some individuals applying to various fire departments have been questioned about prior and/or current cannabis use. With recreational cannabis being legal as of July 1, 2023, this question should no longer be permissible during the application process. This bill adds section 2-231.04(b), which prohibits the County, as an employer, from making any inquire into an applicant's cannabis use.
