SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,		
Maryland, that Section 16-212 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereb		
repealed and reenac	cted with the following amendments:

The County Executive shall establish health and life insurance plans for the benefit of all		
permanent status ei	mployees. Said plans may provide for contributions by both the County and	
participating emplo	ovees toward the cost of maintaining said plans. The benefits established unde	

said plans, as well as any County contributions thereto, may be increased from time to time by

the County Executive, but said benefits and/or contributions shall not be decreased by the County Executive without the prior approval of the County Council by resolution or by a specific reduction of the amount of funds budgeted for said purposes. Any insurer contracted with or procured by the County to provide health insurance to county employees shall offer at least one health insurance plan to county employees that includes a hospital that both provides inpatient hospital care and is located in Prince George's County in the health insurance plan's coverage network for inpatient hospital care. This provision shall apply prospectively to the time of the County contract renewal, extension, or procurement for health insurance plans.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
