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certified as a Police Officer by the Police Training Commission at the time the employee retired; or

(1) Except as provided in subsection (c) or (d), whenever a retired participant is employed or reemployed by an employer, the employee's retirement benefit shall be reduced by \$1.00 for every \$2.00 earned by the employee.

(b) Reduction of benefits; earning new benefits; termination of reemployment.

(2) WHILE REEMPLOYED, THE EMPLOYEE MAY PARTICIPATE IN A RETIREMENT PLAN AND MAY EARN A NEW RETIREMENT BENEFIT SUBJECT TO ALL VESTING AND OTHER CONDITIONS OF THIS ARTICLE AS OF THE DATE OF REEMPLOYMENT AND AS MODIFIED THEREAFTER.

(3) On termination of reemployment, the [[retirement benefit amount shall include any new retirement benefit earned|| RETIRED PARTICIPANT IS ENTITLED TO THE REINSTATEMENT OF THE ORIGINAL RETIREMENT BENEFIT AND TO ANY NEW RETIREMENT BENEFIT EARNED DURING THE PERIOD OF REEMPLOYMENT based on credited service and annual basic pay during the period of reemployment. Any retirement benefit earned during the period of reemployment may be subject to different early retirement reduction factors and optional forms of payments than the [[prior]] ORIGINAL benefit.

(C) When benefits not reduced. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 5-1-515, THE RETIREMENT BENEFIT OF A PARTICIPANT MAY NOT BE REDUCED IF THE PARTICIPANT IS REEMPLOYED IN ANY POSITION OTHER THAN A POSITION IN THE DEPARTMENT IN WHICH THE PARTICIPANT WAS EMPLOYED AT THE TIME OF RETIREMENT.

(c) When benefits not reduced.

- (1) Except as provided in § 5-1-515, a participant's retirement benefit may not be reduced if:
- (i) the employee is retired from the County as a classified employee and is reemployed by the County as:
- 1. an exempt employee under § 802(a)(14) of the Charter, but only for the first 1,500 hours worked in a calendar year;
 - 2. an exempt employee under § 802(a)(17) of the Charter;
